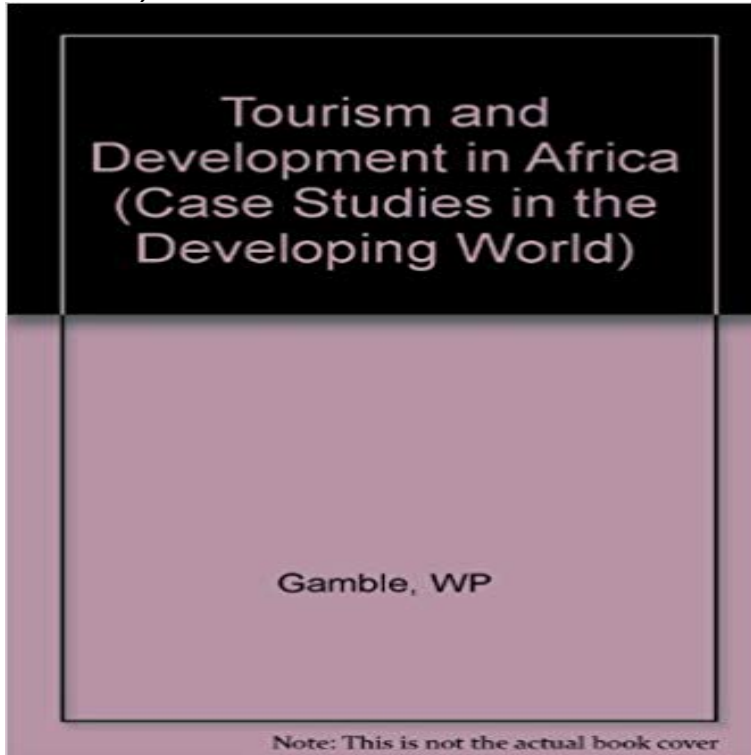


Tourism and Development in Africa (Case Studies in the Developing World)
