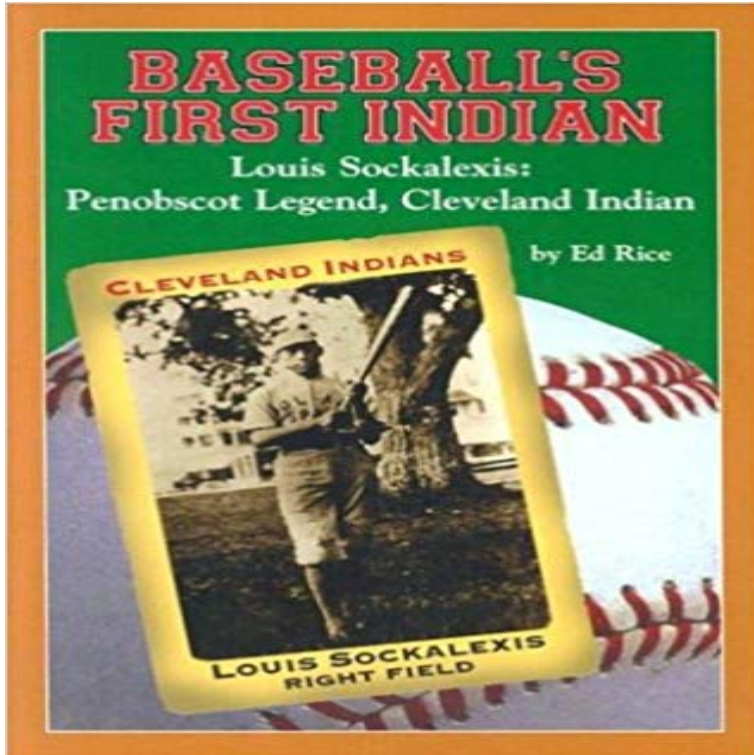


Baseballs First Indian, Louis Sockalexis: Penobscot Legend, Cleveland Indian
