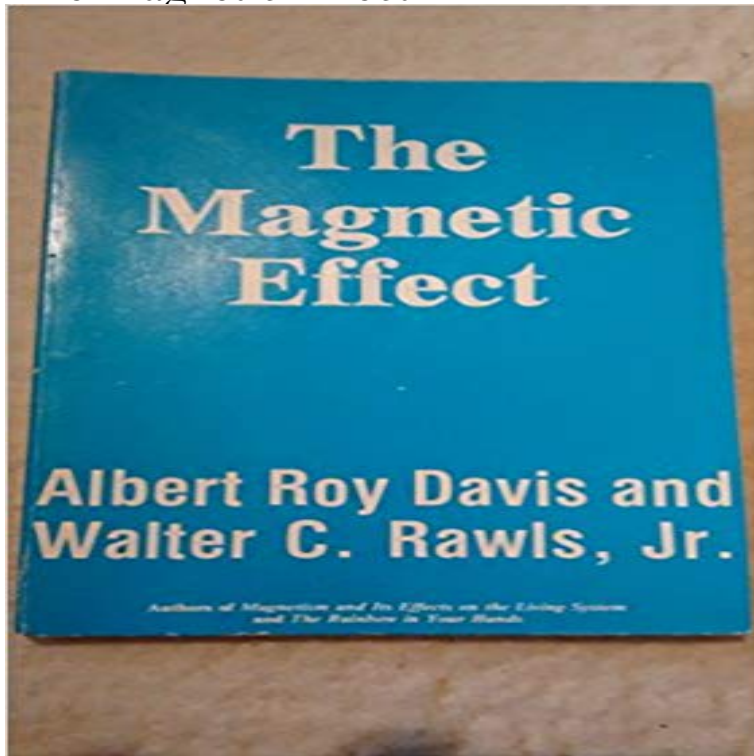


The Magnetic Effect
