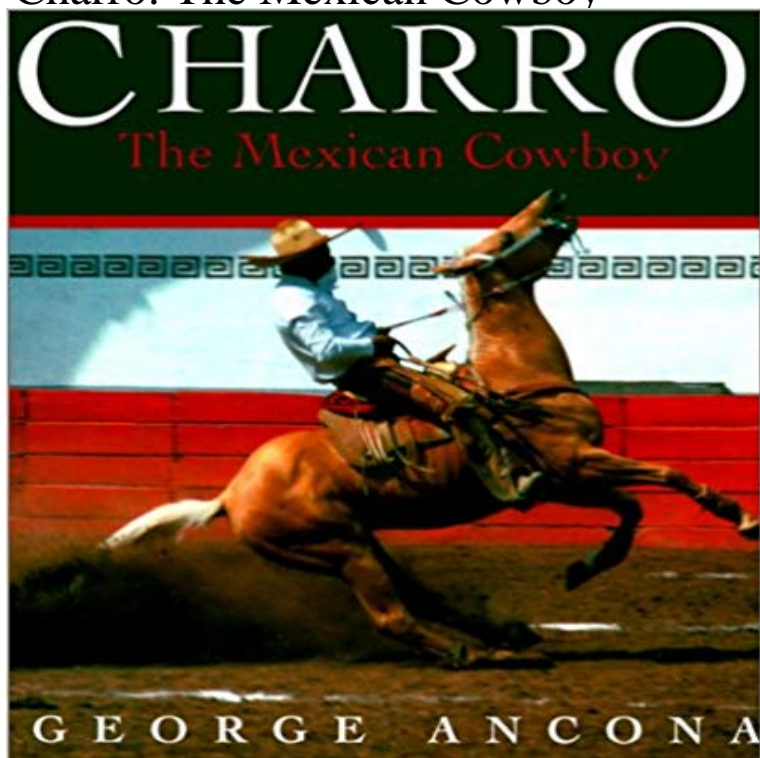


Charro: The Mexican Cowboy
