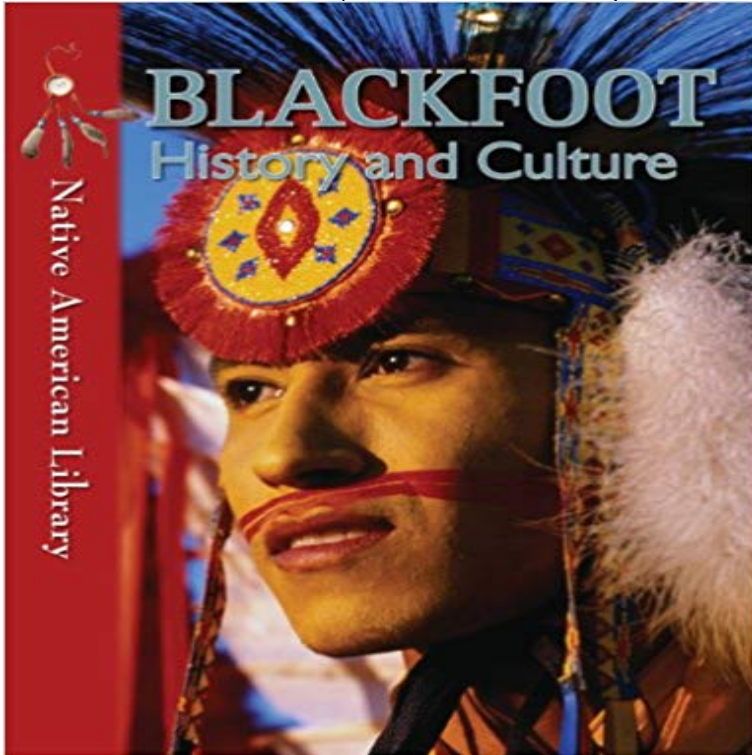


Blackfoot History and Culture (Native American Library (Library))
