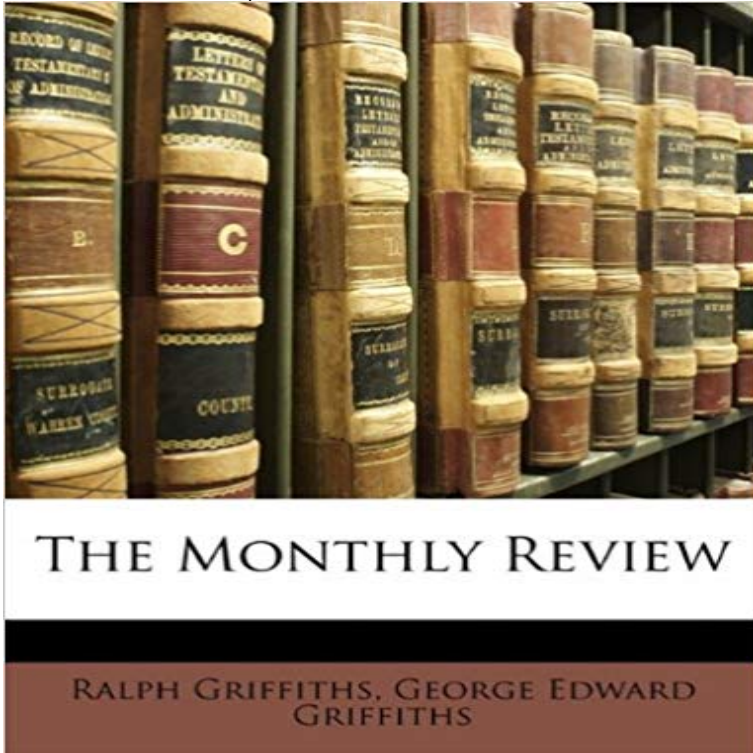


# The Monthly Review
