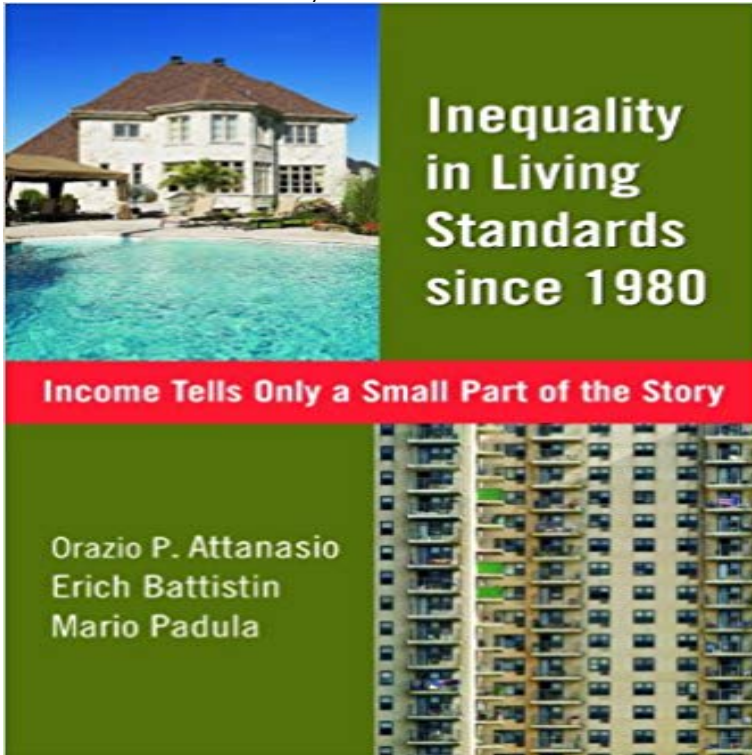


Inequality in Living Standards since 1980: Income Tells Only a Small Part of the Story

But is it really that simple? In this meticulous economic study, Orazio P. Attanasio, Erich Battistin, and Mario Padula contend that the evolution of income and wage inequalities offers only a partial picture of changes in prosperity in recent decades.
