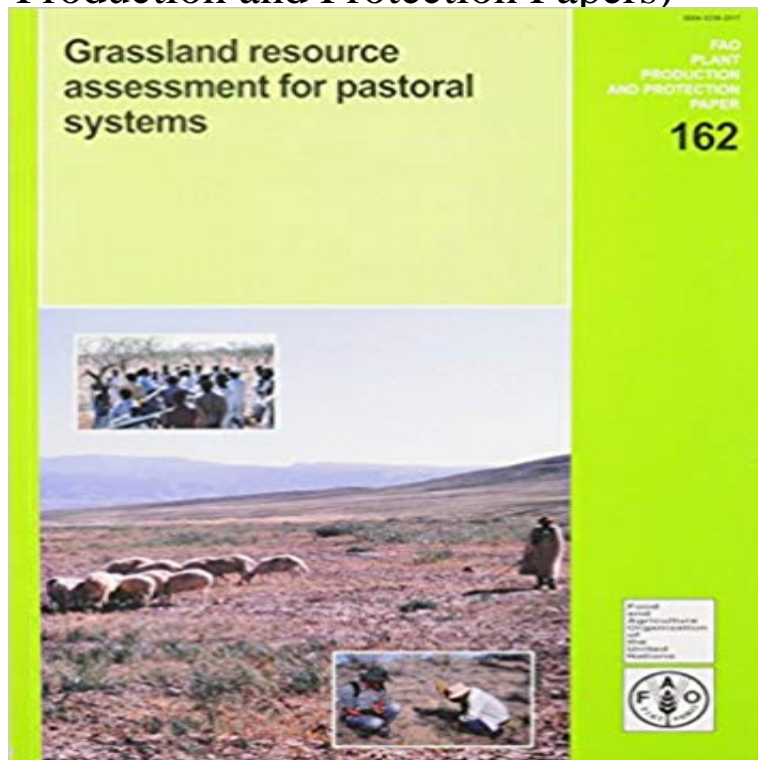


# Grassland Resource Assessment For Pastoral Systems (FAO Plant Production and Protection Papers)
