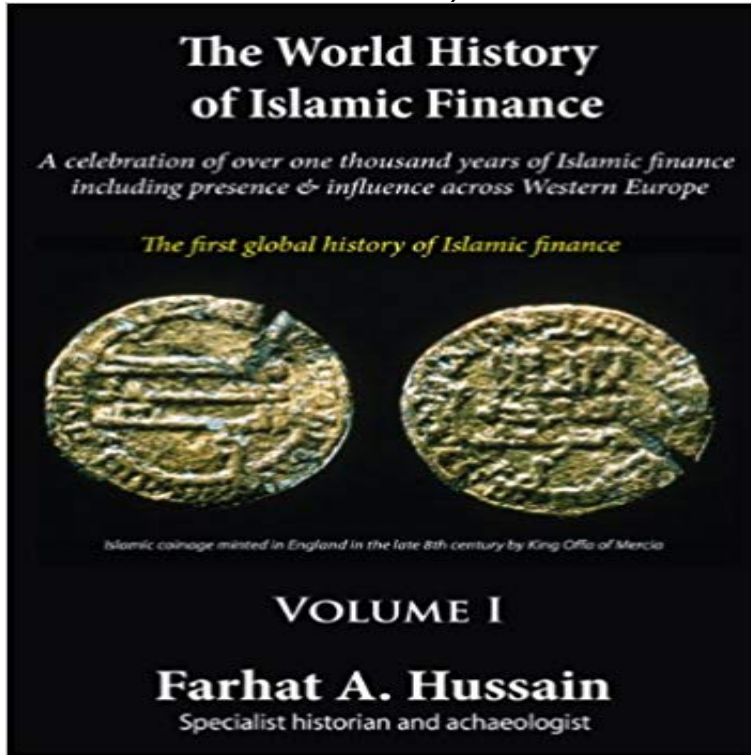


The World History of Islamic Finance (The World History of Islamic Finance Series Book 1)
