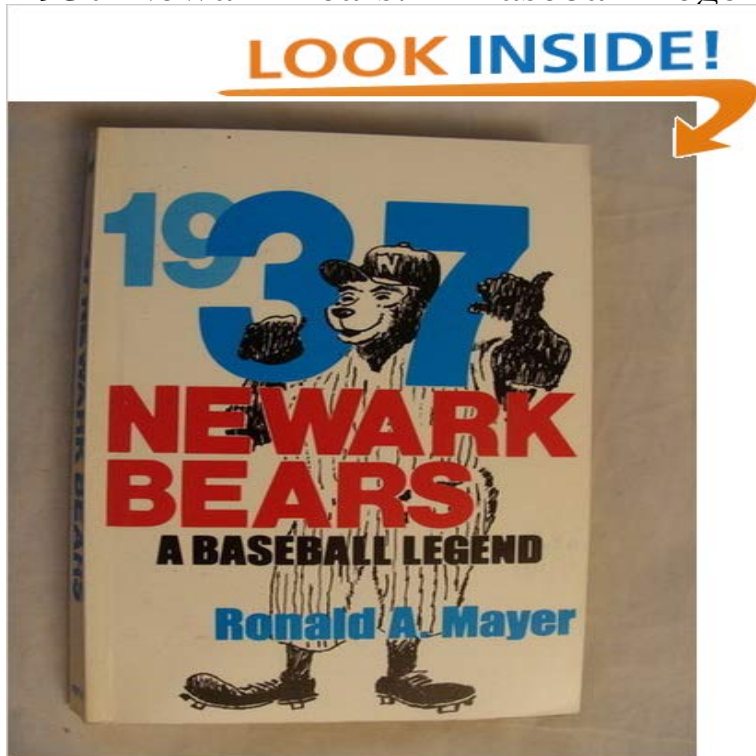


1937 Newark Bears: A Baseball Legend
