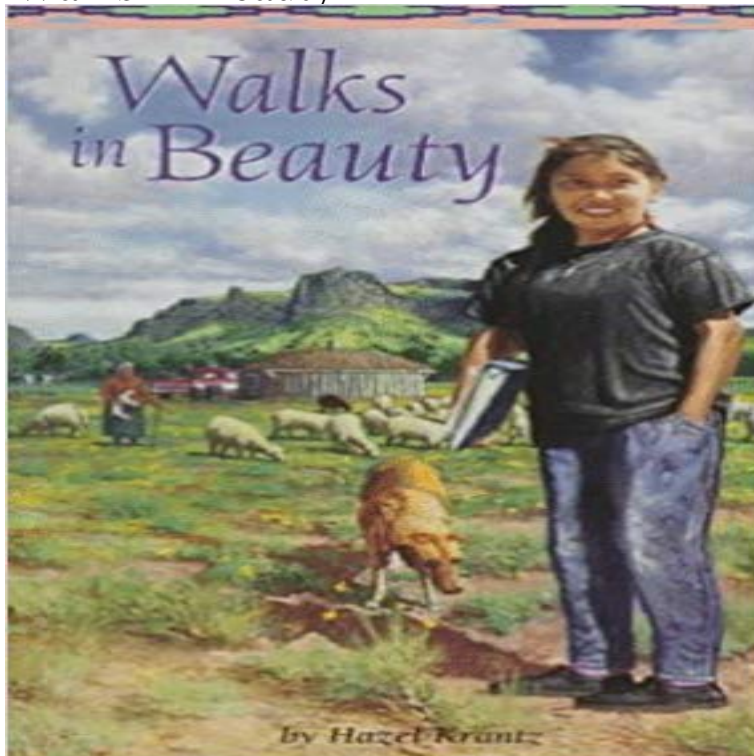


Walks In Beauty
