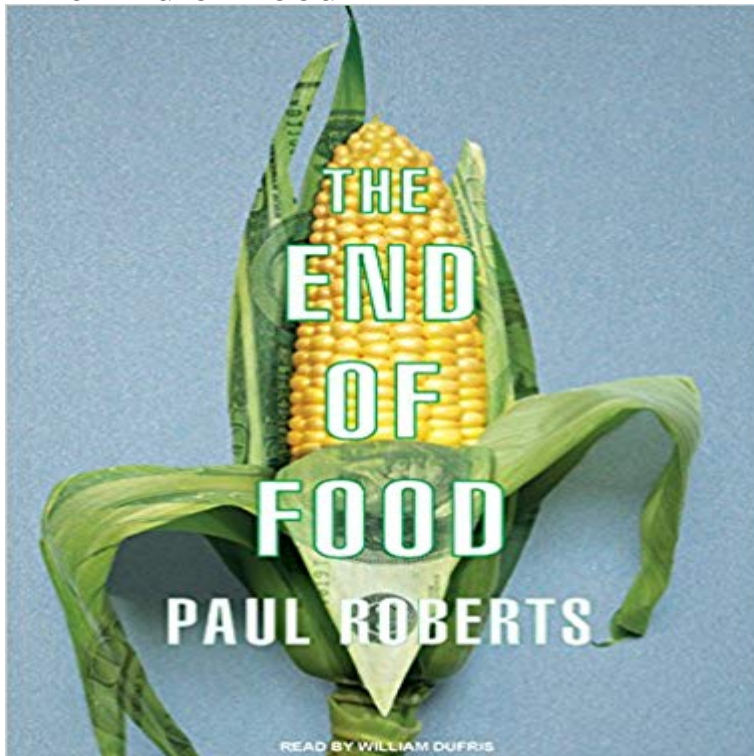


The End of Food
