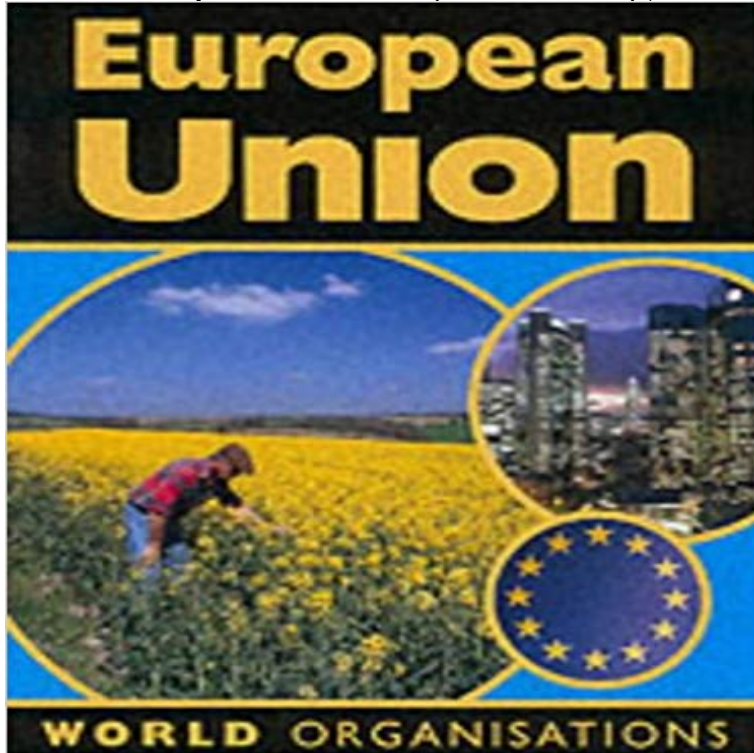


## The European Union (World Organizations)
