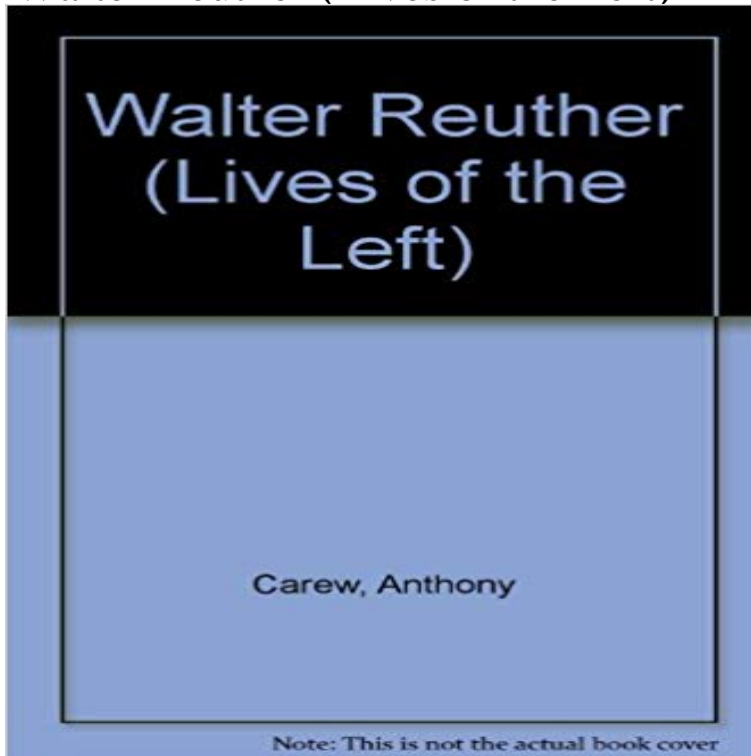


Walter Reuther (Lives of the Left)
