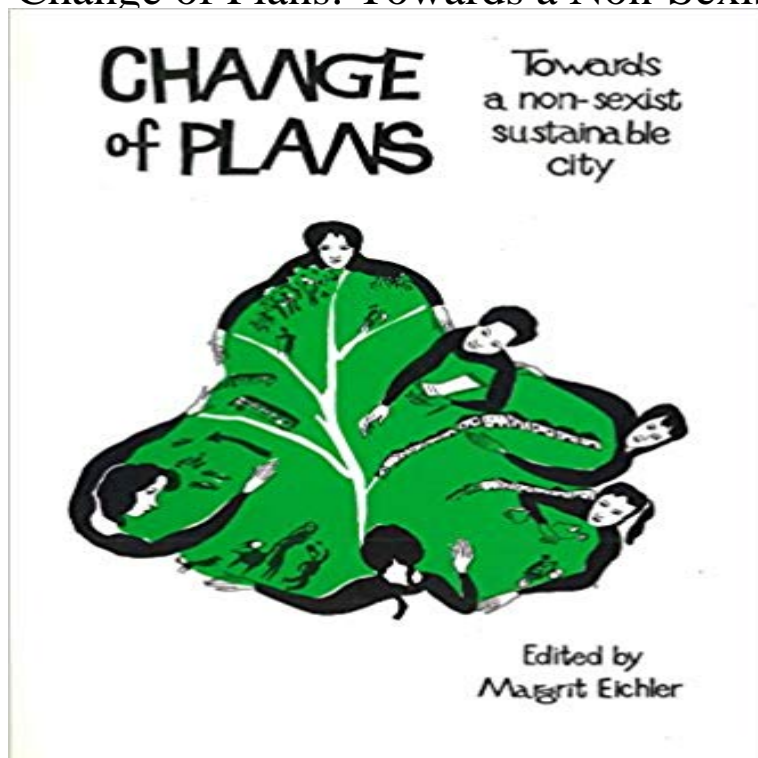


Change of Plans: Towards a Non-Sexist Sustainable City
